

**TO ANY OWNERS OF LANDS SITUATED IN THE
CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF MT. MORRIS, GENESEE
COUNTY, STATE OF MICHIGAN**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that all noxious weeds and tall grass growing and all dead grass and brush on any subdivided land or land along public streets or roads or improved streets, for a depth of 10 rods or the depth of the lots, whichever is the lesser, within the Charter Township of Mt. Morris, County of Genesee and State of Michigan, must be cut down on or before the 1st day of May, June, July, August, September and October of each year or before they reach eight (8) inches in height, to prevent such weeds from going to seed and prevent their re-growth, as the case may be, and to prevent such dead grass and brush from becoming a fire hazard.

“For purpose of this notice, “noxious weeds” shall include Canada thistle (*Cirsium arvense*), dodders (any species of *Cuscuta*), mustards (Sharlock, Black Mustard and Indian Mustard, species of *Brassica*, or *Sinapis*), wild carrot (*Daucus carota*), bindweed (*Convolvulus arvensis*), perennial sowthistle (*Sonchus arvensis*), hoary alyssum (*Berteroa incana*), ragweed (*Ambrosia elatior* L.) and poison ivy (*Rhus toxicodendron*), poison sumac (*Toxicodendron vernix*), oxeye daisies, ragweed, goldenrod or other plants which could be deleterious to health, safety or public welfare is hereby declared a nuisance.”

Failure to comply with this **NOTICE** shall make any party so failing liable for the costs of cutting said noxious weeds and dead grass and brush by said Charter Township of Mt. Morris, said cost to be levied and collected against said lands in the same manner as other taxes are levied and collected.
