

ORDINANCE 96-172

Section 10-244 of Code of Ordinances for the Charter Township of Mt. Morris Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:

A. 1. No minor under the age of 12 years shall loiter, idle, congregate or be in or on any public street, highway, alley, park or public place between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. Unless the minor child is accompanied by a parent or guardian or some adult delegated by the parent or guardian to accompany the child.

2. No minor under the age of 14 years shall loiter, idle, congregate or be in or on any public street, highway, alley, park or public place between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. Unless the minor child is accompanied by a parent or guardian or some adult delegated by the parent or guardian to accompany the child.

3. No minor under the age of 17 years shall loiter, idle, congregate or be in or on any public street, highway, alley, park or public place between the hours of midnight and 6 a.m.,, immediately following, except where the minor child is accompanied by a parent or guardian or some adult over the age of 21 years, delegated by the parent or guardian to accompany the minor child or where the minor child is upon an errand or other legitimate business directed by his parent or guardian.

B. 1. No minor child under the age of fifteen (15) years, unless accompanied by a parent or legal guardian, shall be permitted to play any mechanical amusement device herein before, defined, provided, however, that such minor child shall not be prohibited from operating and playing a pool table, equipped as a mechanical amusement device.

2. No minor child under the age of fifteen (15) years, shall be permitted to remain in any room or place where any pool table is kept pr operated unless accompanied by a parent or adult guardian.

3. Any parent of a minor child who is notified that his or her minor child has been taken into custody for a violation of the Criminal Code of the Charter Township of Mt. Morris, and who refuses to collect said minor child from the authorities or make provisions therefor within a period of (3) hours after notification, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. Upon conviction of a violation of this section, a parent shall be subject to a fine in the amount of the actual cost to the Charter Township of <t. Morris in arresting and detaining the minor child, provided that said fine shall not exceed Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).

4. Except as may otherwise specifically provided herein, any person, firm or corporation violating this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine not exceeding Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) and/or imprisonment for not more than ninety (90) days in jail at the discretion of the Court.

Severability

The phrases, sentences, sections and provisions of this Ordinance are severable and the finding that any portion thereof is unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable shall not detract or effect the enforceability of the remainder of this Ordinance.

This Ordinance shall be published in a newspaper circulated within the Charter Township of Mt. Morris, Genesee County, Michigan.

This Ordinance shall become effective on the date of its adoption by the Board of Trustees of the Charter Township of Mt. Morris.
